WOOD GLAZING STOPS, SURFACE APPLIED MOULDINGS, & LOUVERS

Flush type glazing stops¹ are secured in place one side only with countersunk brads. The other side are placed in loose for removal during jobsite glass installation. Brad holes are not filled in by VT.

Lip type wood glazing stops are installed in the doors. When lip type wood glazing stops are installed the installation process is the same as flush types.

Surface applied moulding may be field or factory applied. (Fastener holes will not be filled). Mouldings may be attached with mechanical fasteners and/or adhesives depending on door type.

Factory-installed glazing and louvers are available, contact factory for details.

¹Glazing compound or tape may be required during glass installation to bring the stops on the loose side flush with the face of the door.
