## WDMA – ANSI CERTIFICATION

VT Industries is pleased to pass on the following announcement received during the month of May 1999 from WDMA.

The American National Standards Institute (ANSI) has recently approved the accreditation of NWWDA I.S.1A-97 *Industry Standard for Architectural Wood Flush Doors* as an American National Standard. The new designation for the standard will be ANSI/WDMA I.S.1A-97.

Accreditation by ANSI provides verification to code officials, architects and specifiers that this document is an industry standard that was developed through an open, consensus process. Several specification writing agencies, including the U.S. Government, have established a policy of relying on consensus standards such as ANSI or ASTM during development of their specifications, when these standards are available. ANSI/WDMA I.S.1A-97 is now the only standard accredited by ANSI for Architectural Wood Flush Doors.

ANSI procedures permit the use of existing stock of the printed standard. ANSI does request, however, that whenever possible a label be adhered to the cover of the existing standard that identifies it as an approved American National Standard, and provides the date of approval. WDMA will provide these labels to all that request them for their existing stock of NWWDA I.S. 1A-97. If you need labels for your current stock of this standard, please contact WDMA and let them know the number of labels you need.

VT Industries specifications are set by WDMA quality standard I.S. 1A-97. Meeting or exceeding standards set forth by WDMA accomplishes the quality of wood doors manufactured by VT.
